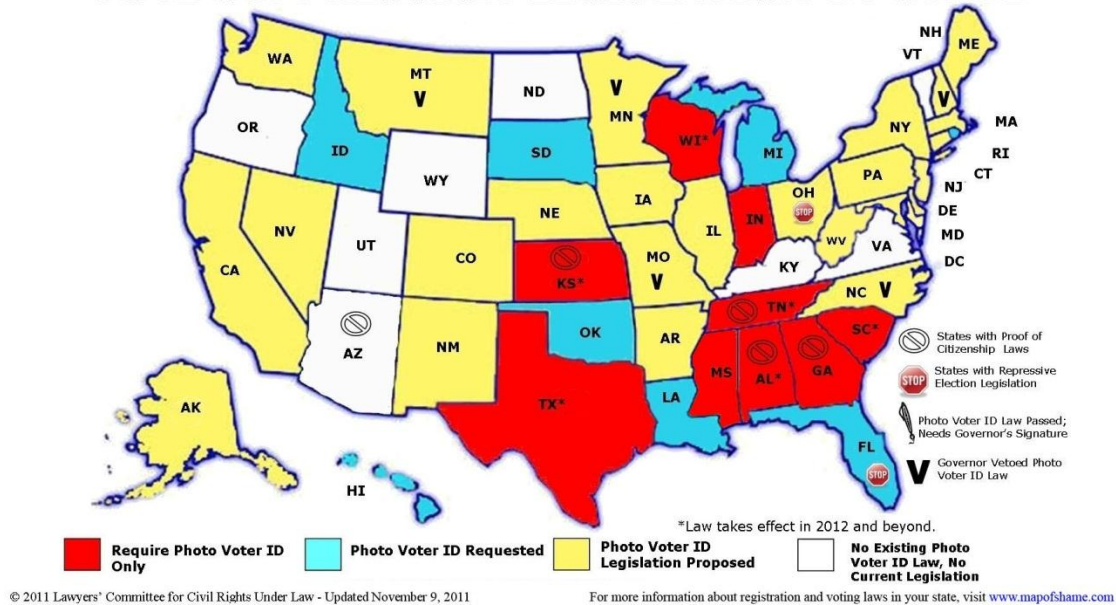




## MAP OF SHAME: VOTE SUPPRESSION LEGISLATION BY STATE
